

Miami-Dade may review Perry Ellis lease after bigotry allegations

The chairman of the Miami-Dade County Commission took steps Tuesday to reconsider Perry Ellis' retail lease at Miami International Airport after the company's incoming CEO was accused of bigotry in a <u>lawsuit</u>.
