Douglas Wigdor's Legal Analysis Featured On The Late Show With Stephen Colbert

A video clip featuring Wigdor LLP Founding Partner <u>Douglas H. Wigdor</u> discussing the high school yearbook of Supreme Court Justice nominee, Judge Brett Kavanaugh, was aired on *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert* on Thursday, September 20, 2018.

The clip of Mr. Wigdor originally aired during a <u>September 19, 2018 episode</u> of MSNBC's *The Beat with Ari Melber* in which he discussed "troublesome" entries from Judge Kavanaugh's yearbook, including references to being a member of the fictitious "Keg City Club" and the euphemistic "Devil's Triangle."

Judge Kavanaugh has been accused of <u>sexually assaulting</u> Dr. Christine Blasey Ford when he was 17 years old. The Senate Judiciary Committee is set to have a hearing on Thursday in which it will hear testimony from both Dr. Ford and Judge Kavanaugh.

According to Mr. Wigdor, the yearbook entries corroborate Dr. Ford's story because they paint a picture of the environment that Judge Kavanaugh was living in at the time of the alleged sexual assault.
