

Wigdor LLP Partners David Gottlieb And Lawrence Pearson Featured In LGBT Bar Association Of New York Podcast

On Monday, July 8, 2019, Wigdor LLP Partners <u>David E. Gottlieb</u> and <u>Lawrence M. Pearson</u> were interviewed by Eric Lesh, Executive Director of the LGBT Bar Association of Greater New York (LeGal), about the Firm's LGBTQ+ discrimination, harassment and retaliation cases on the <u>LeGal LGBT Podcast</u>.

The podcast episode, titled "LGBTQ Workplace Fairness from the Litigator's POV," included a discussion of the Firm's high-profile cases, including a discrimination, defamation and breach of contract lawsuit against novelist <u>Nicholas Sparks</u>, and a lawsuit against <u>Goldman Sachs</u> alleging sexual orientation discrimination and retaliation.

Mr. Gottlieb and Mr. Pearson also discussed a range of other topics related to LGBTQ+ inclusion, including:

- How to prepare plaintiffs to go public with LGBTQ+ discrimination claims;
- The effect of arbitration agreements on LGBTQ+ equality;
- · Intersectionality in LGBTQ+ discrimination lawsuits;
- The potential impact of the Supreme Court's impending ruling on three Title VII LGBTQ+ discrimination cases; and
- Ripple effects of the #MeToo movement on other types of discrimination claims.
